Annual HOA Meeting

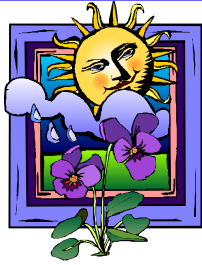
The Annual Homeowners Association meeting is scheduled for **Monday, May 17th from 7pm-8pm at Bailey's Elementary**.

Amberleigh Park Update

Looks like the park application will be re-submitted soon. It should be either during the **April 22nd or May 6th** Council meeting agenda. Thanks to Marsha Moore for forwarding this info along. My impression is that moving the park entrance is not practical (though not impossible) for a variety of reasons. If I am reading between the lines correctly, one of the major reasons is that the Memorial Bridge is not so much off the table but rather on the back burner for now.

After speaking with some residents, I have gotten the sense that some who were originally opposed to the placement of the park entrance are leaning more toward getting park approval and working with the park development group to find ways to encourage traffic along Memorial Dr. Many, like myself, just want a park close by to walk to with their kids. Given my personal experience with the Dublin parks, there never seems to be a great deal of people present at any one time, with the exception when a park shelter has been reserved. I realize, though, that those who may be more directly affected by the park traffic patterns have different and valid concerns. Once I find out the exact date of the next Council meeting, I will forward the information along.

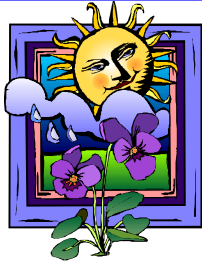
