Pool

Thanks to all who have volunteered to tidy up the pool area in the evenings as well as those of you who do so during the day.

The presence of non-residents in the pool area who are not invited guests continues to be a problem. Because of past vandalism issues associated with such individuals, we are trying to inform them of our policy (see reminder below and online at www.amberleighdublin.org for the complete list of rules) and are asking them politely to leave. It is unfair to be selective in applying this policy, which is why when such incidences occur, we have to ask people who are at the pool at the time to prove either (1) they are a resident by producing a key card or (2) they are a friend of a resident who is present at the pool. It seems only fair that uninvited non-residents should not be allowed use of the pool since they are not contributing financially to its upkeep as well as liability issues in case such an individual is seriously hurt. Again, we apologize for the inconvenience.

Please recall the following:

Children 12 and over are allowed at the pool without adult supervision **only if they are present by themselves**. If they have a guest, (up to 2 non-members allowed), **adult supervision is required**. It has already been observed that children in this age range have been bringing non-resident guests to the pool without any adult in attendance, in many instances bringing more than 2 non-resident friends. If a child wants to bring more than 2 friends, then additional adult supervision is required. For every 2 non-resident guests, there needs to be at least one adult. For example, if two adults associated with a child resident are present at the pool, then that child can bring up to four non-resident friends.

All residents at the pool must have a key card with them.
